NIH Changes to the Biographical Sketch and Other Support Format Page

What Investigators need to know:

- NIH updated its application forms for applications, Just-in-Time (JIT) Reports and Research Performance Progress Reports (RPPR) submitted on or after May 25,2021.
- Effective **January 25, 2022,** applicants and recipients <u>must</u> use the updated Biosketch and Other Support format for applications.
- There are significant changes to the required Biosketch and Other Support format pages.

Biosketch

- New Biosketch template is accessible here
- Under section B Positions, Scientific Appointments and Honor, investigators must include **all** positions and scientific appointments, including
 - Adjunct, visiting and honorary
 - o Fulltime and/or parttime
 - o Positions for which there is no renumeration or compensation.
- Appointments must be listed in **reverse** chronological order
- Section D, Research Support, has been removed for all but fellowship applicants. Section D remains for fellowship applicants, but will only include Scholastic Performance
- If an investigator would like to highlight current or past projects (formerly included in Section D), this information should now be included in Section A, Personal Statement.

Other Support

- Other Support template is accessible <u>here</u>.
- Important Note: Other Support is *not* limited to an investigator's NIH work or funding received through Emory.
- Other Support must include <u>all</u> resources made available to a researcher in support of and/or related to <u>all</u> their research endeavors.
 - o regardless of whether or not they have monetary value, and,
 - regardless of whether they are based at the institution the researcher identifies for the current grant.
- Other Support include but is not limited to:
 - Resources and/or financial support for research; laboratory space/personnel, equipment, or high-value supplies (biologics, chemicals, model systems, etc.) that are not freely available
 - Resources afforded to the investigator through the appointments listed on your Biosketch
 - Students, trainees, and/or visiting scholars working in your laboratory, if they are supported by an external source
 - Research paid for through a consulting agreement. Consulting agreements which do not support research do not need to be included as Other Support

- In-kind Resources: If in-kind contributions are intended for use on the project being proposed, they should be included in the Facilities and Information part of an application rather than as Other Support
 - o If in-kind contributions are **not** intended for use on the project being proposed, they should be included in Other Support.
 - o In-kind contributions included in Other Support must include the time commitment or dollar value of the resource. If this is not readily available, a reasonable estimate must be provided.
- If Other Support includes foreign resources, copies of contracts, grants, or any other agreement specific to senior/key personnel foreign appointments and/or employments with foreign intuition must be included and they **must** be in English.
- Each PD/PI must electronically sign Other Support document to certify the accuracy of the information.

Immediate Notification of Undisclosed Other Support. Please contact your RAS administrator immediately should you become aware of Other Support information that has not yet been disclosed.
