

# New NIH Biosketch and Other Support Formats Now Mandatory

Dear Colleagues,

This is a reminder that effective January 25, 2022, all NIH proposal applications, Just-In-Time requests, and Research Performance Progress Reports (RPPRs) must comply with the new requirements and formats for Other Support and Biosketches. The Office of Research Compliance & Regulatory Affairs (RCRA) has prepared an NIH Biosketch and Other Support educational resource (attached) to assist with compliance with these requirements.

- ✓ **NIH's revised policies require disclosure of all positions and scientific appointments on your biosketch. Please be sure to review your current and past activities to be sure all such appointments are properly included in your biosketch.**
- ✓ **Other Support includes all resources, including international and domestic, along with in-kind resources in addition to the traditional project-based award support.**
